Competition Rules and other information.

- The Competition will be a Four Ball Better Ball Stableford Competition off $\frac{3}{4}$ Handicap. (Maximum Handicap 24)
- The Competition will be open to men who are members of regular Golf Clubs, and who are aged 55 years or over on the date of the Competition.
- Members of Huyton & Prescott Golf Club may not enter the competition unless partnering a guest.
- The Entry Fee is £30.00 per Couple. Cheques to be made payable to **HUYTON & PRESCOT GOLF CLUB LTD.**
- Four Ball groups will be arranged by the Organisers so that as far as practicable, each group contains competitors from at least 2 different Clubs.
- Snacks will be available on the day of the Competition from 8.15 a.m. onwards. Competitors wishing to partake of a cooked meal will be asked to confirm their requirements before they play.
- A stamped addressed envelope must be enclosed with the completed entry form to enable the organisers to advise you of your starting time. These will be allocated as soon as possible, noting any stated preference, on a first come first served basis.
Please Note;- Entry Fees will not be refunded after Starting times have been allocated.
- All prizes will be presented on the day of the Competition. Prize winners must be present, or a named proxy to collect their prize if they cannot attend the prize presentation ceremony. Unclaimed Prizes will be forfeited
- There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th places, and a prize for nearest the pin on the 18th. hole.
- A separate 2's club will be run by the Organising Committee, and the cost is included in the Entrance Fee.
- All Competitors should be in possession of a current Handicap Certificate. A full list of Prize winners and their scores, will be forwarded to their respective Clubs.
- The Club reserves the right to refuse entry of applicants to the Competition.
